NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF TIME

(June 5, 2025)

On May 5, 2025, Southwest Power Pool, Inc. (SPP) filed a motion in the above-captioned proceeding requesting that the Commission grant a 16-month extension of time—from August 12, 2025 to December 12, 2026—to submit its compliance filings to demonstrate that it meets the requirements of Order No. 1920¹ related to interregional transmission coordination. SPP states that good cause exists to grant its requested extension because its interregional compliance process will require considerable coordination with its neighboring transmission providers. SPP further states that its stakeholder process is extensive and necessitates extended time for both regional and interregional compliance. SPP states that the Commission has granted an extension of the deadline for SPP to submit its compliance filing to meet all requirements of Order No. 1920, except those related to interregional transmission coordination, to June 12, 2026. SPP further states that the requested extension will allow for the proper sequencing of its interregional compliance filings to follow its compliance filing to meet all requirements of Order No. 1920, except those related to interregional transmission coordination, as contemplated by the Commission. SPP also asserts that the extension and proper sequencing will allow for a coordinated process with its neighboring transmission providers.

No answers were filed.

SPP's request for extension of time is hereby granted, and the deadline for SPP to submit its compliance filings to demonstrate that it meets the interregional transmission coordination requirements of Order No. 1920 is extended to and including December 12, 2026.
